### How Do I Get Certified?

Register online at [www.publichealthexam.org](http://www.publichealthexam.org) and take the exam at one of the 300 test centers across the U.S. or at a site overseas. The exam tests a candidate's knowledge of the five core areas and seven cross-cutting competencies in public health.

To be eligible for the CPH exam you must have graduated from a **CEPH-accredited school or program in public health**. Those graduating in 2010 must have completed all degree requirements on or **before July 31, 2010**.
