The Summit will also provide training for community organizing and advocacy to reach health equity. The results of the Summit will be incorporated in a State Health Equity Plan being developed by the Department of Health's Office of Health Equity.

A pre-conference tour of the Ho'oulu 'Āina Nature Park in upper Kalihi Valley will also be offered on September 10th.
